Mayor Vlasisavljevich called the meeting to order at 9:25 a.m.

1. Fayal Pond Trails

Director Rosati reported it was originally planned to replace the 6' wide trail on the backside of the pond with a 6' wide trail. Rosati is recommending that portion of the trail be widened to 8' wide. The cost to widen it is \$7,000. The consensus is that widening that portion of the trail to 8' is a good idea. A change order for this will be on the next City Council meeting agenda.

2. Hat Trick Avenue Slip Ramp

City Engineer Johnson reported that he is working on the layout with MnDOT. The design will be slightly different from the initial layout he presented previously. Johnson stated we may have to do some soil borings. Johnson expects to have the plans completed early summer 2023 with a possible summer 2023 bid.

3. New road on east side of Slumberland

Clerk Administrator Monahan-Junek reminded the City Council that at some point St. Louis County is going to want the city's decision on whether the new road to be constructed on the east side of Slumberland will be a private road or a city street. County representatives will be attending a June 6 workshop with the City Council and the ownership of this proposed road will likely be part of the discussions.
